Welcome to a new year at Kahler Middle School. I look forward to seeing returning students and welcoming new students as well.

All students visit the library every two weeks on a scheduled day with their language arts classes. They may check out, return, and renew library books. Students may have two books checked out at a time for a two week period. Books may be renewed if students haven't finished within the two weeks.

Students can also visit the library before and after school, during passing periods and during class time with a pass from their teacher.

Our collection is steadily growing. Using the annual budget as well as Scholastic book fair proceeds, new titles are purchased regularly. A wide range of materials are purchased including eBooks, audiobooks, biographies, fiction and non-fiction. Some titles may be considered "Young Adult," and may contain language and content better suited for our older students. These titles will be marked with a "Young Adult" sticker on the spine.

We try to help our students make wise decisions when choosing a book to read, but also believe that you know your student best. Please be aware of what your child is reading. If you do not want your student to check out books with the YA sticker, please sign and return the bottom of this sheet.
