In most cases, these books are labeled with a sticker that says "YA" (Young Adult). If you would like for your student to be able to check out a book labeled "YA" then please fill out the attached permission slip and have your student return it to the library as soon as possible. If your student does not have permission on file, they will not be able to check out books labeled "YA." Please return this form by September 1, 2023.
